ADMINISTERING & MARKING THE SPELLING TEST

ADMINISTERING THE SPELLING TEST

- On the following page, you will find the **transcript** for STP's Free KS2 2018 **Spelling Test**. This transcript **needs to be read out loud** to the student.
- The spelling test should take around 15 minutes, but can take longer if need be.
- Before administering the spelling test, read out the following instructions:
 - * *Listen carefully to these instructions.*
 - * *There are 20 sentences in your test paper. Each sentence has a word missing from it.*
 - * *I will first read the missing word on its own. Then, I will read the whole sentence with the missing word in it. Finally, I will read the missing word again on its own.*
 - * *I will do this each time for each sentence.*
 - * *Listen carefully to the missing word and write it in the space provided in your test paper.*
 - * *Make sure you spell the word correctly.*

- Answer any questions the student may have before proceeding with the test.
- In the Transcript, there are entries such as the one below:

*Spelling 1: The word is **delighted**.*
*Sam was **delighted** with his present.*
*The word is **delighted**.*

- These should be read out to the student in the following manner:
 - * *Read out loud: "Spelling number 1."*
 - * *Read out loud: "The word is delighted."*
 - * *Read out loud: "Sam was delighted with his present."*
 - * *Read out loud: "The word is delighted."*
- Leave a gap of at least 12 seconds between each and every spelling.
- At the end, read all 20 sentences out again in order from the beginning.
- Give the student time to change any of their answers if they wish.
- When the test is over, say "This is the end of the test."

MARKING THE SPELLING TEST

- Each **correctly spelt word** is worth **1 mark**.
- Half marks **are not to be awarded**.
- If a word requires a **capital letter**, an **apostrophe**, or a **hyphen**, these punctuation marks **must be used correctly** by the student **for the mark to be awarded**.
- Spellings that have been written as **two distinct** or **incorrectly hyphenated** words **cannot be accepted**.

Spelling 9: The word is **selection**.

The bakery had a wide **selection** of cupcakes and pastries.

The word is **selection**.

Spelling 10: The word is **broccoli**.

My sister is eating a great deal of **broccoli** at the moment.

The word is **broccoli**.

Spelling 11: The word is **restaurant**.

"The food at that **restaurant** is awful," grumbled

Gordon.

The word is **restaurant**.

Spelling 12: The word is **parliament**.

This issue will be debated in **parliament** next week.

The word is **parliament**.

Spelling 13: The word is **cousin's**.

Maggie had a wonderful time at her **cousin's** wedding.

The word is **cousin's**.

Spelling 14: The word is **leisure**.

The pool at our local **leisure** centre is never crowded.

The word is **leisure**.

Spelling 15: The word is **science**.

Tina has become a huge fan of **science** fiction movies.

The word is **science**.

Spelling 16: The word is **lava**.

The fast-moving **lava** destroyed everything in its path.
